Background	The 2019 ERGA's Statement of Purpose outlines the Group's Strategic Priorities for the period 2020-2023, including the forward-looking review of the EU regulatory framework applicable to media. As an advisory body to the European Commission, ERGA has committed itself to share its experience with the implementation of the AVMS Directive and to advise in identifying upcoming challenges affecting the media landscape as a whole.
	In 2020, ERGA adopted its first Position Paper on the upcoming Digital Services Act (DSA) and responded on this basis to the EC's public consultation on the future DSA proposal.
	In 2021, following the publication by the Commission of its proposals for a Digital Services Act (DSA) and a Digital Markets Act (DMA), ERGA adopted a Statement (March) followed by Proposals aimed at strengthening the DSA with respect to online content regulation (June). Internal reports were dedicated to the discussions in the European Parliament (EP) on the DSA and to the reflection on a renewed ERGA (December).
	In 2022, ERGA published its priorities for the DSA trilogue negotiations (February) and monitored the negotiations and the first implementation measures (DSCs' nominations). With regard to the European Media Freedom Act (EMFA), ERGA published a position paper for the open public consultation (March) and a position paper on the Commission proposal (November). Two ERGA Academy events focused on EMFA were held: a first meeting gathering experts from academia and NRAs (February) and a second one where the ERGA position on EMFA was discussed with representatives from the Council and Commission (November). ERGA also explored the issue of channels under the control or influence of third countries and adopted an internal report on NRAs' competences and safeguards for independence.
	As set out in the ERGA 2023 Work Programme, the Subgroup's remit for 2023 will be to support the Commission and, where applicable and appropriate, contribute to the legislative debate with the European Parliament and the Council, on the legislation that is not yet in application, notably the EMFA. This might also include monitoring the evolution of NRAs' competences and independence, as well as resources, in light of the evolving EU regulatory framework having an impact on the media sphere.
Subgroup scope and purpose	Against this background, the Subgroup will work in three main directions:  • Workstream 1 – EMFA  The key objective of this workstream will be to support the Commission and closely monitor and timely feed into the EMFA negotiations.

For a subset of topics identified as priorities for the Group, the Subgroup will translate ERGA's position into operational proposals for amendments aimed at contributing to the debate on the EMFA proposal, where appropriate. To this end, particular attention will be put on ensuring that the processes used for drafting and validating the proposed amendments be transparent and inclusive while guaranteeing the necessary – high – level of reactivity.

Depending on the evolution of the legislative debate and the priorities that will emerge (e.g. in the perspective of the trilogues), the Subgroup may consider certain issues in greater depth and coordinate the preparation of further specific positions by ERGA. In this regard, it will also provide expertise on specific topics to the Commission, if requested.

When it comes to external outreach, where relevant, the Subgroup will coordinate with the Board for sharing ERGA's positions and proposals in the context of the debate on the EMFA proposal. It will also contribute to supporting ERGA members' efforts to raise awareness of ERGA's role in the implementation and oversight of the future EMFA.

#### Workstream 2 – DSA

The Subgroup will continue to monitor the degree of involvement of ERGA members foreseen in the national DSA implementation arrangements (as Digital Services Coordinators, competent authorities...).

It will coordinate ERGA's input and participation to the Commission's meetings and/or actions in preparation to the DSA's implementation, in response to the Commission's requests.

Furthermore, where relevant for the Group, the Subgroup will prepare ERGA's positions on the future implementing and delegated acts of the DSA.

# Workstream 3 – Other legislative initiatives and NRAs' competences

As a follow-up to the internal work on the competences & independence of the NRAs conducted over the course of 2022, the Subgroup will focus in 2023 on:

- monitoring relevant EU legislative initiatives touching upon the sector and that may have an impact on the competences of NRAs;
- as a follow-up to the work carried out in 2022, monitoring/analysing the 2023 trends, resulting from recent EU or major national regulatory developments, in terms of changes to NRAs competences, safeguards for independence as well as corresponding NRAs' resources (financial, human and technical) to carry out these new missions.

Moreover, the Subgroup will follow developments on the proposal for a Regulation to prevent and combat child sexual abuse (CSAM). It will examine the relevance to develop a condensed ERGA position (in particular on the interplay with the DSA and AVMSD, and the competences of ERGA members) and, if agreed by the Group, will draft such a position.

Subgroup 2 will consult with Subgroups 1 and 3, where relevant.
